

Honorary Fellowship Award for Datuk Dr Leslie Lam

Datuk Dr Leslie Lam (Class of 1959) has been conferred the Honorary Fellowship of the Faculty of Medicine at University College Dublin. This is the most prestigious award that the Faculty can confer. The purpose of the Honorary Fellowship Award is to recognize and acknowledge the achievements and contributions of certain distinguished individuals who are experts in their particular field of discipline. The criteria for selection is based on an outstanding contribution to research, teaching community/ general or clinical practice with a national/international reputation and /or a major contribution to the development of the Faculty. Dr Lam was awarded The Most Honourable Order of the Crown of Brunei Data Paduka Mahkota Brunei Yang Amat Mulia (DPMB) in 1984 and the Governor of the Society for Cardiac Angiography and Interventions, USA in 1995.

Dr Lam is married to Dr Ivy Lam and is a father of 2 daughters, Patricia and Katherine. Dr Lam has served on the De La Salle School management committee since 1991 and as a heart specialist, has been unfailing in his attention and care of the Brothers. He has been the Consultant Cardiologist (The Cardiac Centre) at Mount Elizabeth Medical Centre since 1988 and is

a member of the council of Fellows which was inaugurated last year and is being chaired by A* Star Chairman Mr Philip Yeo (Class of 1956). He was awarded the Diploma of Benefaction for all his contributions to the Lasallian Family in Singapore by the Vicar General of the Brother, Br William Mann in 2002 during the Jubilee celebration.
